TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS 2017

Article 5

The term of Office of the members of the National Council of the judiciary, selected on the basis of the existing provisions, expires after 30 days from the date of entry into force of this Act.

Article 6

Term of Office of the Disciplinary Ombudsman shall expire after 30 days from the date of entry into force of this Act.

Article 8

Selection of new members of the National Council of the judiciary in connection with the expiry of the mandate referred to in article 5 shall be made within 30 days from the date of expiry of the mandate.

Article 10

The National Council of the judiciary, within 30 days from the date of commencement of the term of Office shall determine the limit of employment in the Office of the National Council of the judiciary, and the General working conditions and salary of the employees of the Office of the National Council of the judiciary.

The President of the National Council of the judiciary, within 6 months from the date of entry into force of this Act, in consultation with the Chairman of the First Assembly of the National Council of the judiciary and the President of the Second Assembly of the National Council of the judiciary, may submit to the head and employees of the Office of the National Council of the judiciary, employed on the basis of existing provisions, new working conditions and salary. In the case of not presenting of the new conditions and salary the employment relationships are solved with the expiry of that period.

Within 60 days from the date of introducing the new working conditions they can be accepted or refused. If new working conditions are not presented to the person employed in the Office the employment relationship is solved with the expiry of that period.

If the head or the employee of the Office of the National Council of the judiciary does not submit a statement of refusal to accept the proposed working conditions within the time limit, it is considered that he agreed to these conditions.

Article 12

This Act comes into force after 14 days from the date of the notice.
