## INFORMATION REGARDING VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

 Most members of the EAJ do not require a visa to enter Armenia, with the following exceptions:

Citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Israel, the Republic of North Macedonia, and Turkey holding ordinary passports can obtain an entry visa for the Republic of Armenia through the following options:

- o **E-VISA**: Via the E-VISA system.
- o At the State Border: Upon arrival in Armenia.
- o Through Armenian Embassies and Consulates.

## **Required Documents:**

- Passport (travel document),
- Completed application form (download here) and a photo (3.5x4.5 cm),
- If available:
  - Flight ticket,
  - o Hotel reservation,
  - o Invitation from a tour company,
  - o Proof of financial means (e.g., bank statement, other evidence),
  - o Health (travel) insurance,
  - Passport pages containing valid visas or residence permits from other countries issued in the past three years,
  - o Other supporting documents.
- Payment of state duty.

## **Important Notes:**

- The passport must be valid for the entire duration of the stay in the Republic of Armenia.
- It is recommended to apply via the E-VISA system. The maximum processing time for applications is three business days.
